President Biden,

The continued persecution of Christians in Pakistan is unacceptable and cannot go unanswered. I urge you to use every diplomatic tool of the United States to secure the release of religious prisoners and address ongoing human rights violations in Pakistan.

Shagufta Kiran is one of many Pakistani Christians who has been denied religious freedoms and persecuted based on her faith. She has been imprisoned, held in inhumane conditions, and sentenced to death for comments deemed disrespectful to Islam. Only with significant pressure from the United States and our international partners does Shagufta Kiran have hope of being released and reunited with her family.

The United States has provided Pakistan with over \$1.2 billion in foreign assistance over the last five years. This is a tremendous amount of American treasure being delivered to an oppressive foreign government with no regard for individual liberties or religious freedom. We must take action to stop the persecution of Christians abroad, and I am prepared to use the full weight of my office to prohibit foreign aid spending to nations that participate in such injustices.

Again, I encourage your administration to use the full diplomatic power of the United States to address these abuses. Shagufta Kiran and countless other religious prisoners depend upon our courage to act. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
